

## **Installation Steps**

## Turn off the power at fuse or circuit box.

- 1. Attach the mounting strap unit (A) to the outlet box using two mounting screws (B).
- 2. Choose the length of the chain (F) you need, then weave the fixture wire and the fixture ground wire through the chain (F), collar (G) and canopy (D).
- 3. Connect the chain (F) to the loop and the top loop on mounting strap unit (A) with two quick links (E).
- 4. Thread the fixture wire and fixture ground wire through the top loop, threaded pipe of the mounting strap unit (A).
- 5. Pull out the outlet wires and house ground wire from the outlet box. Make wire connections using the wire connectors (C):
  - ---The smooth wire (marked) from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.
  - ---The ribbed wire (unmarked) from the fixture to the white wire from the power source.
  - ---Attach the fixture ground wire to the mounting strap unit (A) with the green ground screw, then connect it to the house ground wire with a wire connector (C).

Carefully put the wires back into the outlet box.

- 6. Attach the canopy (D) to the mounting strap unit (A) by inserting the top loop, then tighten the collar (G) to secure it.
- 7. Install the bulb (not included). See relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum wattage allowed.
